

MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET: COLORTONE DECK PROTECTOR

1) IDENTIFICATION OF PRODUCT

- COLORTONE DECK PROTECTOR
- UN Number 1263

2) COMPOSITION

- Contains solvents < 40%

3) HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

- Flammable
- Can irritate skin and eyes
- On ingestion or inhalation, respiratory irritation, nausea, dizziness etc. may occur

4) FIRST AID MEASURES

- Ingestion: Wash mouth thoroughly with water. Do not induce vomiting
- Inhalation: Move into a well-ventilated area for fresh air
- Skin Contact: Wash the affected skin area with warm water and soap

5) FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

- Extinguish fire using dry powder or alcohol resistant foam
- Never use a water jet
- Use protective clothing

6) ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

- Ensure that spillage does not enter drains and waterways

- Store product in a cool dry area
- Keep out of reach of children

8) EXPOSURE CONTROL/PERSONAL PROTECTION

- Ensure that you work in a well-ventilated area
- No smoking around product
- Use of eye goggles, protective clothing and rubber gloves is recommended

- The product is flammable but not explosive
- Not soluble in water

10) STABILITY AND REACTIVITY

- The product should be kept away from temperatures > 60 degrees Celsius
